2022-2023 fiscal year statistics

Families

737 families served
(Number increased by 135 from the previous year)

Housing

31 families who were homeless were housed in our emergency shelters

Food

40,655 pounds of food was given out through our emergency food shelf

(10,650 lbs more than the previous year)

Rental Assistance

Prevented homelessness with rental assistance for 76 families- Assistance aided in eviction prevention, back rent, and entering stable housing.

Meals

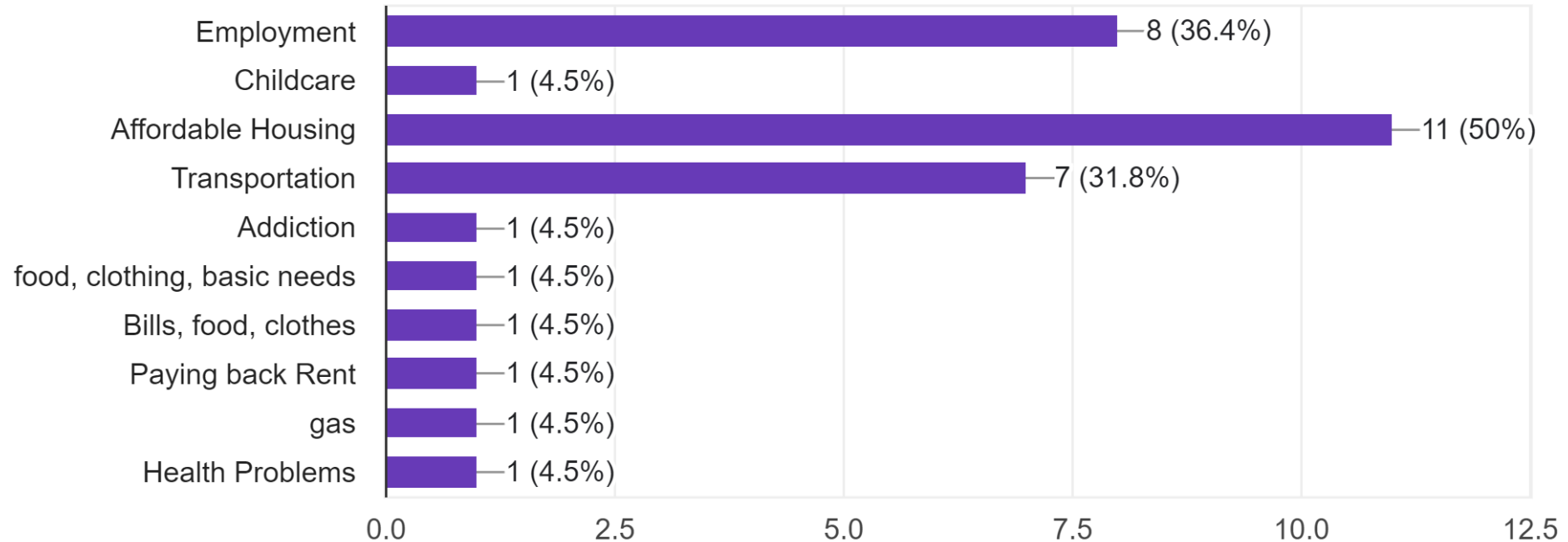
3759 warm meals were served through our Thursday night community meals

What is your biggest challenges in meeting your monthly basic needs?

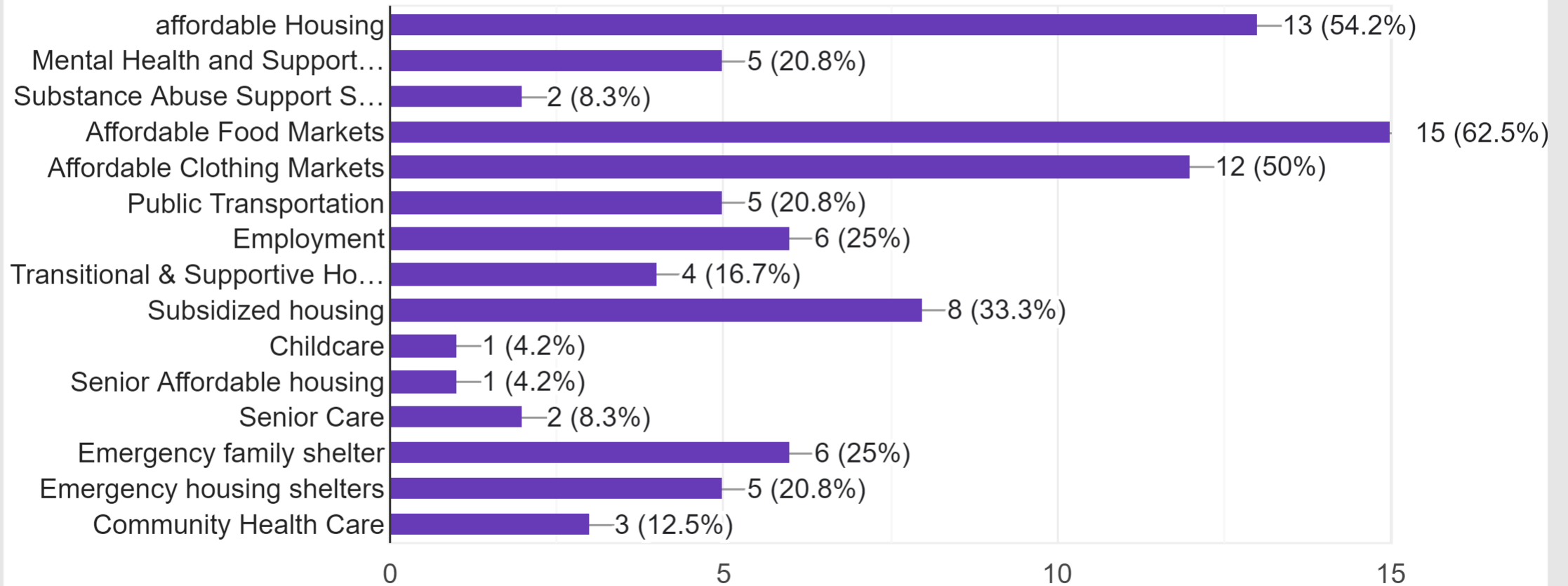
